Essential Requirements:

- 5 or more years of litigation experience
- Previous work in child rights litigation fields
- Updated knowledge of the new criminal codes and special legislations, especially POCSO and JJ Act along with proficiency in court procedures and practice.
- Strong understanding of child-centric criminal jurisprudence and child rights frameworks
- Experience in legal research, drafting, and preparation of court pleadings
- Ability to supervise litigation work, including coordination with fellows on field.
- Experience in mentoring or training junior legal professionals
- High proficiency in written and spoken English

- Strong organisational, coordination, and case-management skills
- Commitment to ethical, trauma-informed, and rights-based legal practice

Desirable Requirements:

- LLM or an equivalent Master's degree in Law
- Previous supervisory experience in child rights litigation fields
- Proficiency in the use of MS Excel, AI tools, and graphic design tools;
- Proficiency in social media outreach

Responsibilities:

- Oversee and coordinate all litigation-related work under the Fellowship (MP)
- Ensure documentation of all case work in the prescribed format
- Coordinate with the UNICEF Office (MP), NLUD, and MPSLSA for case procurement, assigning, and reporting.
- Supervise and mentor Litigation Fellows engaged in case work including routine visits to Ujjain and Jabalpur for effective case management.
- Facilitate training and capacity-building of fellows
- Ensure adherence to professional standards, timelines, and project objective
